

Insurance Cards

In order to ensure that charges are properly billed to insurance, patients must provide current insurance information at every appointment. Failure to provide a current insurance card may result in unnecessary delays, denial of service and/or billing errors.



Collection of Insurance

Copays are required at the time of service. Copays not paid at the time of service will have a \$15 surcharge added to the account to cover billing costs.

New Patients without Insurance

Uninsured patients new to Skagit Regional Clinics (SRC) or Cascade Skagit Health Alliance (CSHA) are required to make a \$131 deposit prior to receiving services. Additional charges may result depending on the services provided.

Elective or Procedures Not Covered by Insurance

Procedures not covered by insurance will require payment in full prior to receiving the service.
